



WALK and QUIZ

Join LVAG for a walk and fun quiz along the banks of the River Loddon

In the August issue of our newsletter LVAG explained that there is a funding shortfall of approximately £2,000 required to meet legal costs arising from the Sandford Farm Public Inquiry held in June this year (visit our website www.lvag.org.uk for more details).

To help raise the money we would like to invite you to take part in a walk around the Sandford Farm area, along the River Loddon (see what we are trying to save!) and join in our fun quiz along the way.

LVAG members will meet walkers for a staggered start. Maps will be available on the day, or will be able to be printed from our web site. To entertain you along the walk you can also enter our quiz, for a minimum donation of £5 per quiz sheet - prizes will be awarded for the highest scoring entries.

This is a walk in the countryside and involves rough paths, one stile, a public footpath across a field and paths close to the river and lakes. All children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult and must be closely supervised at all times. This is a beautiful stretch of the River Loddon (worth saving!) and the fun, but challenging, quiz is well worth entering.

Join us for a very enjoyable morning! and help raise the last of the money.

Should the weather be bad on the day, a message postponing the walk will be posted on our web site or you can call the number above for an update.

This is a fund raising activity, so please encourage as many family and friends that you can to take part. LVAG have represented the views of the majority of residents of Woodley, Charvil, Hurst, Twyford, Sonning, Winnersh and Earley at the Public Inquiry and have had massive support already, we just need that final effort to cover costs. We are expecting a decision from the Secretary of State in November.

The Museum of Berkshire Aviation's car park on Mohawk Way—limited parking available. The Museum has a new cafe, where you can hand in quiz sheets after the walk to a member of LVAG and stop for a coffee and a chat.

Route:

The walk is approximately 5 miles long and will take you along the River Loddon, into Dinton Pastures, back along the river to Sandford Lane. LVAG will help at the crossing of Sandford Lane where the walk will continue along the bank of the river, adjacent to the Sandford Farm site. We will then head to The Lands End pub in Charvil, for refreshments if you choose, and then circle back along Beggars Hill Rd (next to Sandford Farm) back to our starting point.
